Just 100 yards from Kew Bridge Station, the Express Tavern is a traditional English pub offering a step back in time into a golden age where pubs were elegant and unpretentious and served superbly kept ales.

Dating back to 1794 it has been in the same family since 1882. It's on the CAMRA inventory of historic pub interiors, because of the numerous original features still in place. There are no fruit machines, jukebox or pool tables, although there is a piano if you fancy a tune or a singalong.

The Express Tavern retains a separate public bar and a large comfortable traditional saloon with a pleasant garden at the back for summer drinking.

There is always a choice of guest beers and excellent homemade food is available except on Sunday and Tuesday evenings.

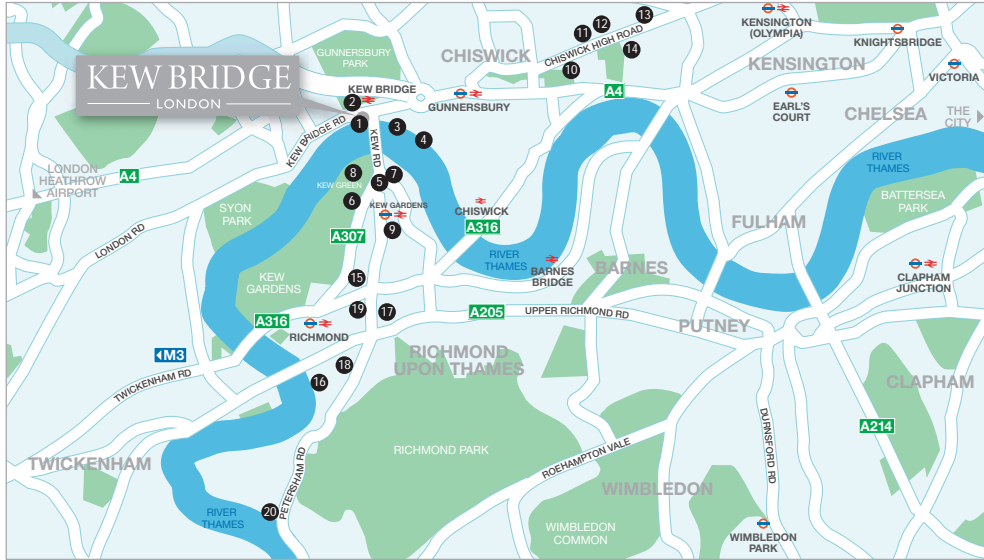
